# June STEAM Spotlight Challenge: DIY Solar Oven

Hello, budding scientists and engineers!

Get ready for an exciting STEAM project that's perfect for the sunny days of June. This month, we're challenging you to build your very own solar oven! Not only will you harness the power of the sun, but you'll also create delicious treats in the process. Let's get started!

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- A cardboard box (pizza boxes work great!)
- Aluminum foil
- Plastic wrap
- Black construction paper
- Tape
- Scissors
- Ruler
- A pencil or wooden skewer
- Ingredients for s'mores (graham crackers, chocolate, marshmallows)

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

#### 1. Prepare the Box:

- Cut a flap on the top of the cardboard box, leaving one side attached to act as a hinge.
- Cover the inside of the flap with aluminum foil to reflect sunlight into the box.

#### 2. Create the Oven:

- Line the bottom of the box with black construction paper to absorb heat.
- Tape plastic wrap over the opening created by the flap. This will create a greenhouse effect inside the box.

#### 3. Set Up the Solar Oven:

 Place the box outside in direct sunlight. Adjust the flap so it reflects



as much sunlight as possible into the box. Use a pencil or skewer to prop the flap at the right angle.

### 4. Cook Your S'mores:

- Place your s'mores ingredients on a plate inside the solar oven.
- Close the box and let the sunlight do the work! Check the oven periodically until the marshmallows are gooey and the chocolate is melted.

#### The Science Behind It:

- Solar Energy: The sun's rays are captured by the aluminum foil and directed into the box.
- Heat Absorption: The black construction paper absorbs the sunlight, converting it into heat.
- Greenhouse Effect: The plastic

wrap traps the heat inside the box, raising the temperature and cooking your s'mores.

## **Challenge Yourself:**

- Try measuring the temperature inside the solar oven with a thermometer.
- Experiment with different designs and materials to see how they affect the cooking time.
- Research other foods you can cook using a solar oven and share your results!
